



Teaching and studying at the HU planned with the greatest possible presence in the winter semester 2021/2022

The Senate Chancellery - Science and Research and the Berlin universities have agreed on key points for the coming winter semester 2021/2022. The universities are preparing a winter semester with teaching and studying that is to take place for the most part in presence again. In this context, infection protection is to be ensured with established hygiene measures and tests, the highest possible vaccination rate and appropriate contact tracing. Only those who have been vaccinated, recovered or tested can take advantage of the offers of the universities on site and gain access to their services. Analogous to the other educational institutions, the abolition of the minimum distance of 1.5 metres is being sought, in strict compliance with these protective measures, in order to ensure the space requirements for teaching and studying in presence.
