



Interview: As of January, retrieve salary statements via Employee Self Service

From the end of January 2023, HU employees will be able to view and retrieve their salary statements digitally via a new service portal, Employee Self Service - ESS for short. Civil servants will even be able to do this with their December payroll already. Behind this is a challenging change process and the conversion to SAP Payroll. As a consequence, employees will also be able to maintain a lot of personal data via ESS within the HU network or via a VPN connection in a web browser and retrieve various certificates. Pay slips by mail will be discontinued. In this interview, Dr. Uwe Eichner, Head of Human Resources Services in the Budget and Personnel Department, reports on the work behind the introduction of SAP Payroll, as well as on data protection and support for ESS.

Energy saving: HU closes buildings over Christmas to January 1, 2023

In the interest of energy conservation, Humboldt-Universität will close its buildings from December 24 to January 1, 2023. Excluded are laboratory buildings, buildings with experimental long-term and live experiments, and the premises required by the Technical Department, the Budget and Personnel Department, and for the SAP implementation and IT support of the Computer and Media Service. Employees who do not have recreational leave between Christmas and New Year's Day or who are unable to draw on time credits are asked to take advantage of the stipulations of the service agreement on mobile working. <u>Learn more about saving energy</u>

Intranet: Automatic translations with DeepL

Since the beginning of December, employees have been able to have content on the intranet translated into one of nine languages at the click of a mouse. The automatic translations are carried out with the help of DeepL and not only serve the readers, but also relieve the colleagues from the university administration: They can now refer to the intranet to provide information to non-native speakers of German without additional effort. Currently, automatic translation works for bulletin board entries, blog posts, comments, and texts placed in wikis or content apps using the rich text editor. Users get the translation offer as soon as they specify a language other than German in their personal settings.
