Berlin Higher Education Act: Statement of the Executive Board on the Complaint to the Federal Constitutional Court

Now, judges in Karlsruhe are to clarify whether the state is exceeding its competences: Represented by its president, the HU filed a constitutional complaint with the Federal Constitutional Court in Karlsruhe on 30 December 2021 against a provision of the new Berlin Higher Education Act. In a statement, the presidium explains how it came to this step and what goals it is pursuing.

Survey: Identifying infection risks and making work at HU safer
