



New Infection Protection Ordinance: FFP2 mask obligation & attendance documentation

Dear students,

As expected, the Regulation on Measures Required to Protect the Population from Infections with the SARS-CoV-2 Coronavirus published last Friday did not result in any far-reaching changes for universities. Only the two following aspects were adjusted:

FFP2 mask obligatory

FFP2 masks are mandatory throughout the campus. This obligation is waived for examinations at the permanently assigned place if the minimum distance of 1.5 m and the 3G regulation are observed. This obligation is also waived for lecturers in face-to-face events at the permanently assigned location if the minimum distance and 3G regulation are observed. There is no mask requirement for participation in university sports activities. However, the 2G+ regulation must be observed here. During university music sessions, where 2G+ also applies, the mask can be removed at the fixed place and in compliance with the minimum distance.

Attendance documentation

The 3G regulation continues to apply to face-to-face teaching and examinations. For this reason, the control of 3G evidence also continues. This means that you are still required to provide 3G evidence when you attend courses taught face-to-face and during face-to-face examinations. However, attendance documentation no longer records the 3G status.
