



Pandemic: Current information on possible openings at Humboldt-Universität

As already known, the federal government has agreed on a three-step process of openings in the Corona pandemic - as of 20 March, a large number of restrictions on social, cultural and economic life are to be gradually withdrawn. What derivations the Berlin Senate will draw from this will be specified in the coming days.

For Humboldt-Universität, this means that the rules of the current service directive will remain in place for the time being, even after 19 March. The 3G rule continues to apply. The admission requirement for all members of the university is proof of vaccination or convalescence or proof of a negative test result, which must not be older than 24 hours, or 48 hours in the case of PCR tests.

Humboldt-Universität, in particular the pandemic staff, is also preparing for further openings and is agreeing on a new service directive. However, we ask all colleagues for patience and flexibility during the transition period of the next two weeks.
