



Helping to shape climate protection at the HU: Invitation to the workshop on 6 July

Research trips and semesters abroad only by train? More digital teaching in winter to save heating costs? Only one printer per institute - does that really make sense?

The Climate Protection Management Team invites all members of Humboldt-Universität to contribute their ideas for climate protection and sustainability measures in workshops and to discuss them together. On 6 July, the focus will be on the field of action of teaching and studies. The suggestions collected will be incorporated into the climate protection concept, which is to be drawn up by the end of this year and submitted to the Academic Senate for a resolution.

What exactly is it about?

In order to understand the connections between one's own actions and climate protection, to participate in the social transformation towards sustainability and to deve-

lop solutions for sustainability-relevant problems, competencies are needed. The integration of Education for Sustainable Development into teaching and studies is one way for students to acquire competencies. But also other ideas for a stronger anchoring of climate protection in the content and methods of the study programmes as well as for the organisational framework conditions in teaching and studies will be discussed in the workshop.

This workshop is moderated by the "Netzwerk n", which mainly networks students, initiative, doctoral students and young professionals at universities. The participants are committed to an overall institutional change at universities in the sense of sustainable development.
