# Next Grand Challenge: "We need concrete solutions to face the complex challenges and crises of the time"

The Berlin University Alliance (BUA), the excellence network of Freie Universität Berlin, Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, Technische Universität Berlin and Charité - Universitätsmedizin Berlin, has announced its third major research programme. In a joint brainstorming process with civil society, the research topic "Responsible Innovation in Times of Transformation" was chosen as the subject of the next Grand Challenge. "As a society, we need concrete solutions to meet the complex challenges and crises of our time" states Christoph Schneider, Vice President for Research and member of the BUA Steering Committee of the Focusing on Grand Challenges. ## Survey: on the perception of scientific contributions in social media

How do researchers perceive scientific posts in social media, especially the sometimes hostile comments? As part of a joint research project at the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich, the University of Klagenfurt and the University of Vienna, a study is being conducted on the topic of "hostility against academics". The study is explicitly aimed at researchers in various qualification phases at German universities. Participation in the online survey takes about ten minutes.
