



Sabine Kunst announces resignation at the end of the year

At today's meeting of the Academic Senate, the President of Humboldt-Universität announced that she will be stepping down from her position at the end of the year. In her statement, Sabine Kunst justified her move as a consequence of the higher education policy course set by the Berlin Higher Education Act, which was amended in September. In particular, she said, the universities were in no way prepared for the legislative changes in §110. Sabine Kunst sees the need to change the situation of young academics, but: "Solving the associated conflicts of objectives will be a task for the next five to ten years. It is therefore necessary to develop a long-term strategy, for which, however, no counter-financing is currently in sight," explains the president. "For these challenges, a new look at what is needed for the university is needed."
