## Humboldt-Tag der Lehre: Mission Statement Teaching & Collaborative Learning and Teaching

This year's Humboldt-Tag der Lehre will take place on 26 April and will focus on the teaching mission statement, which has been in the making since the beginning of the year as part of a broad participation process. Niels Pinkwart, Vice-President for Academic Affairs, and representatives of the Editorial Board will kick off the day by summarising the current state of the discussion on the guiding principles for teaching. Afterwards, the actual work will take place in decentrally organised formats, where discussions will take place in various interdisciplinary formats - from interdisciplinary to subject-focused to subject-specific. Afterwards, the impressions are collected in the framework event. The event will conclude with a panel discussion on the topic of "Collaborative Teaching and Learning" and the presentation of the Preis für gute Lehre 2022.

The Humboldt-Tag der Lehre will take place as a hybrid event where the opening, closing and ceremony can be followed both in person and via Zoom. The decentralised event will take place partly in person and partly online.
