Implementation this semester: COVID 19 pandemic mitigation law

Dear Students,

Last week, the Berlin House of Representatives passed the "Third Law to Mitigate the Consequences of the COVID-19 Pandemic and the Energy Crisis in the Area of Higher Education Law", which, among other things, extends the regulation of § 126b BerlHG, according to which failed exams are considered as not taken, to the winter semester 2022/2023. HU has decided to implement this regulation immediately, even though the law has not yet been published.

As a result, the examination attempts sat and failed in the examination periods of the ongoing winter semester will also be considered as 'not taken'. As in previous semesters, this does not apply to examination attempts that were deemed failed due to unexcused absence or attempted cheating.
