

## **Back on campus: a summer semester in attendance**

After four semesters in online mode, the HU is returning to presence for the summer semester. The Berlin universities and the Senate Department for Science, Health, Care and Equality have agreed on a point paper for the course of study and teaching. In addition to face-to-face teaching, online courses may be required for didactic reasons and due to a corresponding pandemic situation. The decision on this is made by the lecturer in consultation with the respective Dean of Studies.

Access is permitted to all members of the University and visitors without restriction. However, an FFP2 mask must still be worn in the buildings and on all circulation areas of Humboldt-Universität.3G verification is no longer a compulsory entry and participation requirement until further notice, but the university management asks for voluntary compliance with 3G criteria and testing options to protect the health of all members of the university.

As of 1 April, all staff will be required to work in the presence of others. Home office continues to be possible within the framework of the "Mobile Working" service agreement. If no agreement has yet been reached with employees mobile working has been made with staff, but the option is to be used further the possibility is to be used, it is still possible to work according to the previous agreements until the end of May. As of 1 June, mobile working will require a corresponding agreement in accordance with the DV Mobile Working.
