



Climate protection at the HU: Mobility survey and registration for workshops

The HU climate protection management team, Wiebke Hampel and Kerrin van Bergen, is asking all staff and students to take part in a short, anonymous mobility survey and would like to thank everyone who has already taken part. The results of the survey are important for the HU's climate protection concept, which the climate protection managers are working on together with other actors and which will be developed in the course of the year. The aim is to make an important contribution to saving university greenhouse gas emissions by drawing up a climate protection concept and implementing climate protection measures.

With the help of the survey, university greenhouse gas emissions will be determined and evaluated. The aim is to design mobility strategies that are climate-friendly, efficient and practicable for HU members. For example, business trips or traveling to the campus will be examined. It takes about 15 minutes to take part in the survey. The survey will run until 2 June.

Workshops in summer - participate and help shape

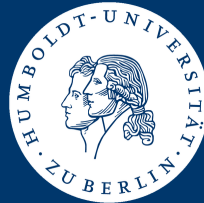
