I would like to take this opportunity to share some good news with you in the context of our pandemic management. Nationwide, free citizen testing services have been phased out as of July 1, 2022. However, we have now succeeded, together with our service provider MediCare, in maintaining our free test offer until further notice for you as students. This means that you can continue to be tested free of charge at the Adlershof Campus (Erwin Schrödinger Center) and the Mitte Campus (university building at Hegelplatz). The student ID card must be presented as proof of participation in an attendance event.
