In order to achieve better comparability between various grading systems, the Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin follows the European Union regulations providing relative grades in the form of grade distribution tables¹. For that reason, the HU Berlin uses a reference group selection based on the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED)². The data for ECTS grading tables are generated annually. The reference period includes three previous calendar years at the time of data collection respectively.
